Imran Khan refutes claims of inciting GHQ protests, calls May 9 riots 'false flag operation' Former PM says masses were incited by 'humiliating' abduction of a former prime minister



Soon Times Correspondent Imran Khan, the founder of Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI), on Wednesday stated that a narrative has been created with an agenda to accuse him of inciting the public to protest at the General Headquarters (GHQ) during the May 9 riots.

In a statement released on the social media platform X (formerly Twitter), he clarified that in the nearly three-decade history of PTI, there has never been an instance of violent protests. "Over the past two and a half years, the worst tactics were used against PTI to

incite violence," he added. In November 2022, he said that there was

In November 2022, he said that there was an assassiant on attempt on him, and even his request for an FIR of his choice was denied. The former prime minister further revealed that his residence was attacked twice by military personnel. On one occasion, during his court appearance, there was a deliberate plan to assassinate him by deploying plainclothes individuals, he added.

On May 9, he evaplained that the masses were incited.

On May 9, he explained that the masses were incited by the humiliating abduction of a former prime minister and the leader of Pakistan's largest and most popular political party, which could have led to a

major incident.

He added that PTI's political training does not include elements of violence and the party believes in political, constitutional, and legal struggles. Inram Khan said that May 9 was a false flag operation. "Those who stole the CCTV footage of May 9 are the real culprits of that day. Their intellect is such that they compare the May 9 incident to the Capitol Hill protest in the USA, where a thorough investigation and review of CCTV footage led to the punishment of only those involved.

Ambassador Blome appreciated Pakistan's contribution to counter-terrorism and underlined the U.S's commitment to supporting Pakistan in various areas, including countering regional threats, economic collaboration, renewable energy, climate management, and education. He underscored that the

U.S.-Pakistan partnership goes beyond security and includes significant investments in health, trade, and development sectors Ambassador Mariam Madiha Aftab, Additional Secretary (Americas), Ministry of Foreign Affairs, stated that the U.S.-Pakistan relationship is dynamic and multifaceted, covering areas such as health, trade, defense, and energy security. She emphasized the importance of economic collaboration, security cooperation, educational exchanges, and climate change initiatives. In 2020-21, PPHI budget was about 15 billion PKR, which is only 19% of what was needed for the people they serve.

Most of the health budget goes to large hospitals, leaving very little

for primary health care facilities that actually see more patients for maternal and child health. The money meant for developing the money meant for developing the health sector often goes to building new hospitals and improving facilities, but a lot of this budget isn't used properly. For example, from 2016 to 2020, 85 billion PKR was allocated to health projects in Sindh, but only 52% out of total 44 billion PKR budget was used. shain, outonly 32% out of total wised, including for COVID-19 response and building or upgrading hospitals and medical colleges. A big portion of the budget for these projects wasn't spent by the end of the fiscal year.

PIC Overturns Ministry of Foreign Affairs' Restrictive Information Request Procedures

Islamabad: The Pakistan Information Commission The Pakistan Information Commission (PIC) has decisively rejected the restrictive procedures imposed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) for filing information requests under the Right of Access to Information Act, 2017. The decision follows an appeal by Nacem Sadiq, a resident of Karachi, challenging MOFA's stringent requirements. In response to Sadiq's appeal, MOFA had stipulated that appellants must adhere to a specific procedure and complete a detailed form. The form required personal details

such as name, CNIC, profession, contact information, and email ID. Additionally, it included a category section marking the information as Confidential, Secret, Top information as Confidential, Secret, Top Secret, or other, and mandated the purpose of the query. Notably, the form contained an undertaking that the information seeker would use the information seeker would use the information solely for personal purposes and would not share it without MOFA's permission. The form also required signatures from the seeker and two witnesses. The Commission found these requirements to be inconsistent with these requirements to be inconsistent with the spirit and provisions of the Right of Access to Information Act. 2017.

Five dead as Nepal plane skids off runway and catches fire, media and officials say

Harris, whose campaing says she has secured the Democratic nomination, led Trump 44% to 42% in the national poll, a difference within the 3-percentage-point in a July 1-2 poll, both within the same margin of error.
Harris and Trump were tied at 44% in a July 15-16 poll, and Trump led by one percentage point in a July 1-2 poll, both within the same margin of error.
While nationwide surveys give important signals of American support for political candidates, a handful of competitive states typically tilt the balance in the US Electoral College, which ultimately decides who wins a presidential election.

Blast at Jose Cuervo plant in Mexico's Tequila kills at least five people
