

others in Islamabad.

"August 5 marks the day of PTI founder's arrest, we will stage protests on that day," Qaiser said while referring to the deposed prime minister's arrest in the Toshakhana

case.
PTI members facing a vicious witch-hunt'
Lamenting the indiscriminate crackdown
against the party, the former National
Assembly speaker alleged that the PTI
lawmakers and social media activists were currently facing a vicious witch-hunt.
"This crackdown is being done after the

Supreme Court's verdict [on the reserved seats]," he said, urging the apex court to take a suo motu notice on the matter.

The Supreme Court, in its short order on July 12, allowed the PTI to receive seats in the assemblies reserved for women and

minorities.

In the landmark ruling, the apex court directed the PTI to submit a list of its eligible candidates for reserved seats to the electoral body within 15 days of the verdiet.

The ECP should then publish the list of reserved seats of the candidates on its website within seven days, the SC ruling stated.



Sri Lanka's chase was off to a flier with an 84-run opening partnership between Pathum Nissanka (79) and Kusal Mendis (45). Arshdeep Singh provided India with a much-needed breakthrough by taking out Kusal.

#### **Emotional Dressel spearheads** US to first Olympic gold in

PARIS A formidable United States spearheaded by an emotional Caeleb Dressel stormed to the men's 4x100m Olympic freestyle relay title on Saturday for the country's first gold in

Paris.
The quartet of Jack Alexy. Chris Gulfiano, Hunter Armstrong and Dressel came home in Jainin 92-88e with Austrial tasking silver in 310-32 and Italy bronze in 310-70. The Americans, who were reigning champions, had their work cut out after the opening leg with Chinese 100m world record holder Pan Zhanle putting in a scorching two laps.

100m world record holder Pan Zhanle putting in a scorching five laps. But the US hauled themselves back into contention with Dressel powering them to the finish line. Kyle Chalmers put in a cracking final leg to hand Australia silver, with his 46.59 the fastest split of any swimper.

any swimmer.

China, who are competing under a doping cloud, finished out of the medals in fourth.

Innshed out of the medals in fourth. The United States have long dominated the event, winning 10 of the 14 times it has been on the Olympic programme before Paris. For Dressel, 27, it was his eighth gold medal from three Olympics, and he was tearful in the celebrations.

"I mean, you can't help it. You can't explain this moment. So you're on the podium watching the flag go up. Hunter (crying) actually happened before the flag went up. Soif's really special seeing that," he said.

Dessel won five golds in Tokyo three years ago but took time out from the spot before coming back in time to qualify.

He appreciated seeing his younger team-mates Guiliano and Alexy win their first Olympic golds. "I remember how it was for me with my first gold. I mean. Hostif."

"No one can take that away from us," he added.
There was more emotion for Dressel when he was able to celebrate with his wife Megan and their
