Govt disallows suspension of social media apps during Muharram



The federal government on Friday disallowed suspension social media applications and switching off mobile phone signals during Muharram "to maintain peace."

The Punjab government has a day ago requested the centre to suspend social media apps Facebook, TikTok, X (Twitter) and WhatsApp from Muharram 6 to 11 after receiving information of subversive activities from across the border.

According to sources, the foderal government has turned down the request and directed the authorities concerned to make foolproof security arrangements during Muharram. However, it allowed to turn off mobile phone signals only in those places where processions and gatherings are held.

The Punjab government has recommended to the federal interior secretary to ban social media from 6th to 11th Muharram to control spread of hate material and misinformation to avoid sectarian violence.


PTI founder may go on hunger strike: Ali Muhammad

Three killed in IED blast targetting police van in Mardan

Punjab seeks Army, Rangers' assistance for Muharram security

The Punjab government has sought assistance of Pakistan Army and Rangers to ensure 'peace and security' during the holy month of Muharram
"Law enforcement agencies (LEAs) will render their services for the peaceful observance of Muharram," said a

statement issued by the Punjab Home Department's spokesperson. According to the statement, the Punjab government has sought deployment of 150 contingents of the Army and Rangers following the requirements of different districts.

The Punjab police sent a letter to the home department, requesting the deployment of 69 contingents of the Army and 81 squads of Rangers across Punjab to

and 81 squads of Rangers across Punjab to assist in providing security during Muharram," it added. The assistance of the security forces have been sought from the 1st to the 12th of Muharram, depending on the needs of each district

The request for assistance was made in a

The request for assistance was made in a letter written by the Home Department to the Pakistan Army and Rangers, in response to a request from the Punjab Police for additional security measures. Pakistan has witnessed a surge in terrorist activities across the country, especially in KP and Balochistan, since the outlawed militant group Tehreek-i-Taliban Pakistan ended its ceasefire with the government in November 2022. November 2022.

"We are starting the second round of the 14th presidential election to choose the future presidential rform among the two candidates across 58,638 polling stations in the country and all stations abroad, "Interior Minister Ahmad Vahidi said, according to state TV.

The vote comes against the backdrop of heightener regional tensions over the war in Gaza, Iran's dispute with the West over its nuclear programme and popular discontent at the state of the country's sanctions-hit economy.

In last week's first round, Pezeshkian, who was the only reformist permitted to stand, won the largest number of ballots, around 42 percent, while the former unclear negotiator Jalili came in second place with 39 percent, according to figures from Iran's elections authority.

Israel tells Gaza ceasefire negotiators to resume work



GAZA (Agencies) - Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu has decided to send a team of negotiators to discuss a hostage release deal with Hamas

US President Joe Biden welcomed the development, which comes a day after Hamas responded to a Gaza ceasefire plan he outlined in late May. The last indirect talks took place in Cario earlier that month. Details of Hamas's latest response have not been made public, but a Palestinian official said that the group was no longer demanding a full ceasefire at the outset of the plan presented by Mr Biden. A senior US administration official said Hamas had agreed to "pretty significant adjustments" to its position. "We've had a breakthrough on a critical impasse," the US official said, although he stressed that "this does not mean this deal is going to be closed in the period of days". President Biden and Prime Minister Netanyahu held a phone call on Thursday, which focused on the hostages and

Netanyahu held a phone call on I hursday, which focused on the hostages and ceasefire negotiations, the official said. On Wednesday, Hamas's political leadership said it had contacted mediators from Egypt and Qatar about ideas it had been discussing with the aim of reaching an agreement.

Up to now Hamas has demanded an end to op to now rannas has demanded an end of the war and a full withdrawal of Israeli troops from Gaza. Israel says it will accept only temporary pauses in the fighting, until it eliminates Hamas.

When he amounced the plan on 31 May, President Biden said it was based on a more detailed Israeli proposal, and that it involved three phases.

The first would include a "full and complete ceasefire" lasting six weeks, the withdrawal of Sraeli forces from populated areas of Gaza, and the exchange of some of the hostages—including women, the elderly and the sick or wounded - for Palestinian prisoners held in Israel.

The second phase would involve the release of all other living hostages and a "permanente and to hostifities".
